Learn about Solstice traditions around the world on a walk at Prescott Farm.

Prescott Farm to host Solstice Walk for Dec. 22

LACONIA — The Prescott Farm Solstice Walk will take place on Tuesday, Dec. 22, from 5 to 6 p.m., and visitors of all ages are welcome to join in.

With just nine hours of daylight on that date, New Hampshire will be experiencing the shortest day before the amount of light starts its slow increase again. During the walk, educators will discuss why the length of day changes throughout the year and share solstice traditions from around the world.

Prescott Farm is a nonprofit organiza-



nization that offers environmental education for all ages throughout the year including WildQuest camps, public programs, field trips, long-term partnerships with local elementary schools and NOW Fledglings Nature-Based Preschool. The 160 acre historic family farm features woodland and field trails, a “green” build-

ing with geothermal and solar energy systems, historic barns, an old-fashioned maple sugaring operation during the month of March, heritage gardens and forested pond. Prescott Farm is open year round, seven days a week from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m.. There is no charge to go for a hike or explore the “green” building.
