

Title: Forest Folk

Description: The forest surrounding Prescott Farm is one of our most valuable resources and needs to be monitored and managed in order to maintain its health. We are looking for a team of volunteers who are interested in helping us care for our forest and make sure it is available to visitors for years to come.

Team Members: Forester & Forest Folk

- **Forester:** Responsible for creating and updating the forestry management plan. Also responsible for contacting the volunteer coordinator for scheduling work days. *The forester must attend all Forestry Meetings in-person or digitally.*
- **Forest Folk:** Responsible for maintaining safety during work days and carrying out the projects designated during the forestry meetings. *Strongly encouraged to attend Forestry Meetings.*

Time Needed:

Season: March through October,

Days: Work Days as needed, and for monthly meetings.

Times: Flexible

Tasks and Responsibilities: Creating and Forestry management plan, maintaining forestry management plan, nullifying any potentially dangerous trees (and moving wood to maple shack), meet monthly regarding forest progress and any changes caused by nature and/or people.

Qualifications: Ability and experience using tree related equipment including chainsaws, axes, saws, and other tools. Comfortable working in the woods and on trails.

Training: All Forest Management team members will attend the Forestry Service Learning Opportunity.

Safety: Safety is of great importance at Prescott Farm so we ask that team members bring and wear appropriate clothing for the conditions and activities they will be working. Closed toed shoe or boots. Gloves, bug repellent, sunscreen and/or hat. Nothing is more important than safety. Bring all tools that you may need to the working event and always use safe practices when working.
