WildQuest Camp Junior Counselor (JC) Application

About WildQuest Camp: Since 1999, Prescott Farm's environmentally-focused WildQuest Camps have offered youth ages 5-17 the opportunity to explore, learn, and grow in nature. During the New Hampshire school vacation weeks in late February and April and during nine nature-themed weeks each summer, WildQuest campers develop ecological awareness through our enriching day camp programs. Most of the camp day is spent outdoors taking part in nature activities, animal and plant identification, arts and crafts, Quests, games, and hands-on learning.

Junior Counselor positions are available for all summer sessions which run Monday-Friday, 9:00 am to 4:00 pm from June 26 to August 25, 2023. JCs are required to commit to a minimum of 2 sessions of the summer, ideally consecutive. There will be a mandatory JC training on Thursday, June 22, 2023 at Prescott Farm. Time of training TBA.

Application Deadline:

Those interested in being a JC should apply by April 1, 2023. Those who apply by then will be given priority and will be notified within the next two weeks if they have been accepted. Any applications received after April 1 will be considered if spaces remain available.

JC Responsibilities:

- Assist instructors in set up, take down, and running of activities
- Interact with campers, help them complete crafts, activities, recipes, etc.
- Lead a game or activity during second week; optional but highly encouraged
- Other duties as assigned

What you gain from being a JC:

- Develop important leadership skills by observing instructors and interacting with campers
- Learn not only the *types* of activities taught at WildQuest Camp, but more importantly *how* they are taught, organized, and planned
- Gain work references and employment skills
- Build the foundation for potential future work as a paid Camp Instructor
- Be part of a fun and diverse community of children and instructors

Who should apply for a JC position?

This position is for highly motivated teens (15-17 years old). WildQuest Camp JCs are enthusiastic about working with children, have a love of the outdoors, and are interested in enhancing their leadership skills, including communication, teamwork, decision making, confidence, and creativity.

Applications are accepted on a rolling basis. Qualified applicants will be interviewed in person or on Zoom.
